WE Are H.E.R.E

We would like to offer your student the opportunity to participate in a program at Fremont Public Schools called "We Are H.E.R.E". This program helps provide a student with personal care items and is intended for families who currently may be experiencing a financial burden. The first personal care item distribution is set to be delivered the last week of month; typically, October, December, February, April and the first week of June. Here's how this program works: students enrolled in this program will receive a cloth bag with the following items in it: shampoo, soap/body wash, toothbrush, toothpaste. (Deodorant, floss (sanitary products) will be included for students in Middle School and High School. This program is completely confidential. There is no cost to participate. If you enroll your student for this program, they will continue to receive bi-monthly bags until you indicate it is no longer needed. This program is being coordinated by "We Are H.E.R.E." at the Hope and Healing Center with the support of the churches and businesses in this community. If you feel like your student could benefit from this opportunity, please have them come by the Guidance Office at the high school to pick up an application. Just ask for the "We Are Here" applications. Students in Middle and High School will pick up their self care kit in the office once the program starts.
