- The **FAFSA** is now open! The link for this can be found on the **Senior Google Classroom** or at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov)
  - The **Gerber Foundation Scholarship** application will open on **Wednesday, October 1, 2025**, and will close on **February 28, 2026**, at **4 pm ET**. The student application link and scholarship flyers are on the Foundation's website at: <https://www.gerberfoundation.org/scholarships/>. On the website you will find information for each scholarship. There is a Frequently Asked Questions section to the website, which will help address questions students may have.
  - Information about the **MIAAA Scholarship** is available in the Athletic Office. To apply, students must be **seniors** and meet at least one academic requirement, **either a 3.5 GPA or an 1100 SAT score**. Applicants must have participated for at least **two years in two sports** and earned at least **one varsity letter in each of those sports**. In addition, students must complete the application and submit one letter of support from a staff member, teacher, or coach. The **application deadline is January 30, 2026**. For the application and more information, please stop by the Athletic Office.
  - The **ChoiceOne Bank 2026 Scholarship** program has begun accepting applications and will run through **Sunday, March 8**. This is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded based on 500 word or less essay submission and location. There will be a total of **19 students selected as Scholarship recipients**. All students must complete their applications online at: [choiceone.bank/scholarship](https://choiceone.bank/scholarship).
  - The **Gerber FCU** has now opened up their **student scholarships**. There will be three local high school seniors chosen to win the **cash prize** (prizes of \$2000, \$1500, and \$1000).
